# Dauph'International Youth

- Dauph'International Youth is a **humanitarian student society** of Paris-Dauphine PSL University, London campus.
- Founded in 2017, we aim **to help disadvantaged population** and victims of natural disasters.
- This year, the association is **composed of 18 members** who aim to carry out a humanitarian project at the end of May.
- After 3 missions, DIY wishes to **continue its project** undertaken last year in Tanzania alongside International Volunteer Service and the PDS organisation.



# Perspective Development Skills

- PDS is a **charitable organisation** located in the village of Kibele in **Zanzibar**, Tanzania.
- Founded in 2017 by Mr. Hamad, PDS aims to **fight the unemployment rate** (17%) due to poverty, **reduce inequality in term of education** for children from an early age and **empower women**.
- Since its establishment, PDS **has created over 400 jobs** in the village of Kibele in Zanzibar.



# What were our missions?

## 1. Educational mission

- to assist teachers in the **teaching of children** aged 4 to 6 years
- **building a school** to allow children to study children to study in the conditions they deserve



Thanks to the intervention of the DIY, **2 classrooms** were built and this made it possible to accommodate a total of **120 children** whereas previously only 70 could be accommodated.



## 2. Playful mission

- To offer children both **physical and artistic activities**
- To make children aware of **good eating habits and nutritional balance.**



### 3. Environmental mission

- To raise children's awareness of **climate issues and recycling** to make them actors in tomorrow's world
- Organise a **clean-walk** with the children to clean and **collect plastic waste** in their village

# Summary of the project

**GOAL:** to reduce child illiteracy in the village of Jendele and Kibele

Perspective Development Skills is **seeking funds to continue the construction of classrooms** for kindergarten and primary school students as well as recreational and care facilities for the children.

The **construction of the school** started in 2019. For the past three years, the school has been in operation and is home to **over 100 children**.

But as **a school grows**, so does the **number of students and the number of applications**.

The overall aim of the project is to provide sustainable facilities.

To achieve this, **the classroom building is to be constructed during 2023**.

The PDS charity is officially requesting **funding of Tshs 200,000,000 / = (\$86,957) to implement the project**.

## Problem encountered

With increasing in the number of pupil's enrolment in nursery school each year, PDS has opportunity to welcome only few from them. The rest who are many **cannot continue because of lack of spacing** at PDS Charity School and other neighbor schools.

The situation in rural areas communities in some areas of Zanzibar is worse than expected. Children from communities walk an average distance of **3 kilometers to access a school**. They also need to **walk on dangerous road** with plenty of cars.

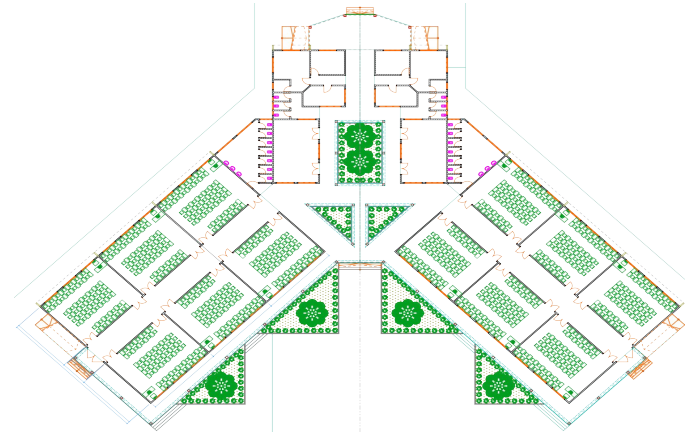
As a result of this phenomenon, children between the ages of **4-7 years do not go to school**. Children are always **late for school and exhausted**. This is why, 4 out 10 children **have to stop their education before the end**.

# Prospectives of the project

There is long term plan for the development of PDS Charity School. The plan is logically set up to show the importance of providing a **“School of Dreams”** for the children of the Central District

The students from PDS Nursery will **continue their studies** in this School of Dreams that will be located in **Jendele village where PDS will have its permanent accommodation.**

Apart from this School of Dream in this area, PDS is **planning to build other infrastructures** such as Hospital, Community Center, Vocational Training, Football Pitch.



## Objectives

- To provide **better, affordable and reachable education** services to the children in both Kibele and Jendele villages.
- To create **employment opportunities** for teachers and support staff in both Kibele and Jendele
- To **reduce on the rate of crimes**

## Activities

- ❖ Building permanent classrooms and offices
- ❖ Building dormitories
- ❖ Registration of more children
- ❖ Recruitment of more teachers



# Project benefits

The benefits of the project can be categorized into **educational and social benefits**.

- The **primary beneficiaries** of the project are the **school children**, especially the nursery and primary school children. They will now be able to further their education to the lower primary school level (standard 1 and 7) and soon an opportunity to continue into the secondary school level (form 1 to 4).
- On **the social benefit**, education is fundamental to life and national development. With better education, one can improve the quality of his or her life.

# Budget

- **Target Group:** Nursery and Primary Pupils
- **Catchment Figure:** One hundred and sixty (160) Nursery Pupils and 100 Primary School Pupils. This is the estimated figure for PDS Charity School and the surrounding.
- **Funding Amount for the whole building:** Tsh 200,000,000/= (\$ 86, 957)
- **Funding Amount for one class room up to finishing:** 17,000,000/= (\$ 7,000)
