- Many children live in a single parent household or are orphans living with extended families.
- These households struggle to get food and basic supplies. They live in a single-room made of corrugated iron sheet with no electricity, sewage or running water.










GROWING UP IN MATHARE

- Although public primary schooling has technically been free since 2003, parents with children in public school reported <u>paying up to \$100 per child for a year</u>. Many households cannot cover such expenses. Therefore, large portion of the school age population <u>does not have access to education</u>.
- During the school day, children and teens from Mathare are often seen idle, playing outside or wandering
 the streets ,which makes them <u>highly vulnerable to gang recruitment</u>, <u>trafficking</u>, <u>prostitution</u>,
 <u>involvement in drugs and alcohol</u>, <u>crime and rape at an early age</u>.

OUR MISSION

We want to give the underserved children of Mathare a chance to have a better future through access to quality education. It is also an opportunity to reduce poverty in this unprivileged community in the long run.

The school Roots Institute Centre provides <u>free</u> <u>education</u>(pre-school and primary), <u>nutritious meals</u> and <u>a safe</u> environment within Mathare Kosovo Community.

Roots Institute Centre is registered in Kenya as a **CBO** ("Community Based Organization") and accredited by the Ministry of Education.



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OUR IMPACT IN 2023

- Provide education and learning opportunities to 380 underserved kids every year
- Provide a safe learning environment with the acquisition of 290 m² land.
- Deliver **food twice a day** for improved nutrition and higher school attendance.
- Support local businesses by sourcing food and supplies within the community.
- Created **14 jobs** in an highly unemployed area.
- Sponsored financially 36 youths to join High School
- Acquisition of school furniture/material for creative activities and sport.



OUR OPERATIONAL COST FOR THE SCHOOL ONLY

We currently operate with an annual budget of 30000€: **56%** of the budget is allocated to **salaries** & **36%** to the **food** program.













This was an emergency measure due to the change of curriculum impose by the Ministry of Education.



Building a permanent structure for generations FROM classrooms made of iron sheets TO a school made in concrete





Our Goal: Building a permanent structure for Generations FROM <u>classrooms made of iron sheets</u> TO <u>a school made in concrete</u>

11 Classrooms made of iron sheets on the ground floor without window and ventilation measuring not more than 20 m² (min 12m²) accommodating up 40 kids.



11 Classrooms made of **concrete** in a two-floor building. measuring **45 m2** with sufficient **windows** to provide light and ventilation.

A rustic kitchen with no water supply and no proper ventilation for fumes containing 3 jikos, a table and a wooden cupboard. The food is stored away from the kitchen.



A spacious and well-ventilated kitchen with supply of clean water for cooking and washing utensils, surfaces that are easy to clean and maintain, close to food store and free from contamination and pest control..

2 Toilets for the all school without water supply & 1 Toilet for staff



Proper toilet facilities with lavatory sinks

12 toilets and urinals

No continuous water supply due to water shortage in Mathare & No electricity






